1. General Information

2. The State University of Zanzibar (SUZA) was established by Act No. 8 of 1999 of the Zanzibar House of Representatives which was then amended by Act No. 11 of 2009, and further re-amended by Act No. 7 of 2016, Act No 1 Part 4 of 2019 and Act No. 13 of 2020. The last three amendments have justified SUZA to merge with other Zanzibar higher learning institutions; these are the then Zanzibar Institute of Financial Administration (ZIFA), College of Health Sciences (CHS) and the Zanzibar Institute of Tourism Development (ZIToD), Kizimbani Agricultural Training Institute and the Zanzibar Journalism and Mass Media College (ZJMMC). His Excellency Dr. Ali Mohamed Shein, the President of Zanzibar and Chairman of the Revolutionary Council is the Chancellor of the University. The University became operational in September 2001.

3. Campuses of the State University of Zanzibar

Currently, SUZA consists of ten campuses that are found at equally beautiful but different locations within the islands. Nine campuses are located in Unguja and one campus in Pemba Island. These campuses are;

1.	Tunguu	-	Main SUZA campus located about 12 km away from Zanzibar Town.
2.	Nkrumah	_	Located at Beit el Ras along the coast of the Indian ocean 5 km away from Stone Town
3.	Vuga	-	Located in the heart of the famous and historic Stone Town – Zanzibar
4.	Chwaka	-	Located at Chwaka Village; scenic fishing village about 30km away from Zanzibar Town
5.	Kizimbani	-	Located at Kizimbani village and famous as spices firm village
6.	Maruhubi	-	Located at Maruhubi which is situated along the Indian Ocean sea shore 4 km away from Zanzibar town
7.	Kilimani	-	Located at Kilimani area which is 1.7km away from Zanzibar town
8.	Benjamin Mkapa	-	Located in Mchangamdogo at Pemba Island.
9.	Mbweni	-	Found about 6 km away from Zanzibar town.
10.	Mnazimmoja hospital	-	Situated in Stone Town.

4. Admission Requirements

Candidates wishing to pursue undergraduate degree or non-degree programmes at the State University of Zanzibar have to fulfil the general minimum entry requirements as well as the specific entry requirements as per academic programme.

5. Undergraduate Degree Programmes

4.1 General Minimum Entry Requirements

A candidate shall be eligible for consideration for admission to a Degree programme of The State University of Zanzibar if the candidate has the following qualifications:

i. Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (C.S.E.E.) or equivalent, with passes in FIVE approved subjects THREE of which must be at Credit level obtained prior to sitting for the Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (A.C.S.E.E.) or equivalent;

AND

(Direct Applicants)

ii. Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (A.C.S.E.E.) with two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points (6.0 points for health related programme) in Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective programme.

Note

- 1. For all Applicants except Graduates of 2014 and 2015:
 - A = 5; B = 4; C = 3; D = 2; E = 1; S = 0.5 and F = 0 point
 - The minimum Principal in this case is an 'E' grade.
- 2. For graduates of 2014 and 2015:
 - A = 5; B + = 4; B = 3; C = 2; D = 1; E = 0.5 and F = 0 point.
 - The minimum Principal in this case is a 'D' grade.
- 3. Principal level passes in Divinity/Islamic Knowledge are not counted

iii. An appropriate equivalent Diploma of a GPA not less than 3.0 for Ordinary Diplomas or B average for Teacher Education and Health Related diplomas or Distinction for unclassified awards or B grade for Full Technician Certificates or Upper Second Class for non-NTA diplomas obtained from a college/institute which is fully registered by NACTE OR from university which is registered by TCU and approved by the SUZA Senate

6. Admission Regulations

5.1 Application Regulations

Note

All foreign applicants who want to join SUZA, he/she should submit their credits/transcripts to NECTA (https://www.necta.go.tz/) for secondary school certificate holder **OR** NACTE (https://www.nacte.go.tz/) for diploma/equivalent for grading equivalent purposes before proceeding to the application.

5.2 Regulations Governing Selected Candidates

Selected applicants must observe the following regulations:

- a) All admitted students are expected to conform entirely to University regulations.
- b) All foreign students are required to apply for a Residence Permit from their nearest Tanzanian Embassy before they depart for Tanzania.
- c) Students who have been selected but cannot join the University for any reason cannot defer the admission to the next year.
- d) The deadline for registration of first year students is strictly two weeks from the first day of orientation week and on Friday of the second week after the beginning of the first semester session for continuing students.
- e) New students are required to submit for registration: copy of their Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE), Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) or Diploma/Degree Certificates, one up-to-date passport size photographs, registration form and filled medical examination.
- f) Except in exceptional circumstances, no students will be allowed to change courses after four week of the beginning of the first semester.
- g) No change of names by students will be entertained during the course of study at the University. Students will only be allowed to use names appearing on their certificates.
- h) No student will be allowed to postpone studies after effective commencement of an academic year except under special circumstances. Permission to postpone studies will be considered after producing satisfactory evidence of the reasons for postponement and written approval from the sponsor. **Note** Each case will be considered on its own merit.
